

Use of cookies on the SK-NIC website

Cookie files

To ensure the proper functioning of this website, we sometimes store locations of your devices in small data files, so-called cookies. This is a common practice of all sites.

What are cookie files

A cookie is a small text file that a website uses to store your location in your browser on your device or mobile device when browsing. With this file, the website for some time stores information on your steps and preferences (such as login name, language, font size, and other viewing settings), so next time you visit the website, you do not need to submit this preferences again.

How do we use the cookie files on the SK-NIC website

This website uses cookies to remember the user settings, respectively especially for additional user identification and the necessary web communication functionality. Without them, registrar acts can't be properly performed. Their acceptance is therefore a condition for communication with the SK-NIC server.

A regular user who does not log on the web is not limited in this way and may not do anything at all.

How to have control over cookies

You can control and/or delete cookies at your discretion. Find details on the page aboutcookies.org. You can delete all the cookies stored on your browser and make most website stop collecting them. In such case, however, you may have to change some settings of every website you visit manually, and some features will not work properly.
